We have completed our investigation and your identity theft claim appears to be valid. Therefore, we have deleted the Wachovia/WFS Financial trade line from your credit file. The credit reporting agencies can take up to 60 days to remove this trade line. You maybe contacted by Wachovia Corporate Fraud Investigations regarding this matter. Additional steps you may want to take to help protect your privacy are as follows:

- Report this incident with the credit reporting agencies and request that a fraud alert be placed on your file and have the above account blocked due to fraud. Also, obtain a copy of your credit report from each agency to see if any additional accounts were opened without your consent.

- Contact the Social Security Administration's Fraud Hotline at 800-269-0271 to report unauthorized use of your personal identification information.
- Contact your State Department of Motor Vehicles to see whether the Department has issued an unauthorized license number in your name. If so, notify them that you are a victim of identity theft.
- File a complaint with the Federal Trade Commission ("FTC") at 877-IDTHEFT. Ask for a copy of ID Theft: When Bad Things Happen to Your Good Name, a free comprehensive guide to help you guard against, and recover from, identity theft.
